








The Oakland K - 8 Public Schools NJSLA ELA Results by Subgroup Program




The Oakland K - 8 Public Schools NJSLA Math Results by Subgroup Program

The Oakland K - 8 Public Schools Notable Achievements

- In comparing the 2022 data with the 2023 data, the percentage of students (Grades 3-8) who Met and Exceeded Expectations increased in ELA, Math and Science.
- In ELA and Math the percentage of students (Grades 3-8) who Met and Exceeded Expectations was greater than the State average.
- ELA scores in Grades 6-8 in the Exceeded Expectations category were double the state average.
- Grade 8 students doubled their performance in levels 3 & 4 in Science compared to the 2022 results.
- Math scores in Grade 8 in the Meeting and Exceeding Expectations categories showed a 50% increase from 2022.
- ELL and Special Education Subgroups (Grades 3-8) increased in their performance in the Met and Exceeded Expectations categories for both ELA and Math from 2022.
- When analyzing the combined Race Subgroup, the number of students in Grade 5 & 8 who Met and Exceeded Expectations in Science showed a significant increase from 2022.

The Oakland K - 8 Public Schools Interventions

- Math and ELA pacing guides and curriculums were revised based with a more in-depth focus on standards and differentiation.
- The number of teachers attending Conquer Math for Professional Development was expanded to include all middle school math teachers and a selection of K-5 teachers using ESSER III Grant funds.
- In Science, Professional Development took place throughout the summer for grades K-8 using natural phenomena to drive instruction using Title IV Grant funds.
- Small Group virtual tutoring was implemented for the ELL subgroup focusing on language and reading acquisition using ESSER II Grant funds.
- Linkit! data warehouse will continue to be used to analyze data and make predictions through benchmark assessments, including the newly launched Science benchmarks.
- Family engagement activities to foster a home school connection in Math & Science are being implemented throughout the school year using ESSER III.
